The acceptance and fulfillment of the general terms of this agreement entitle you to enroll as a student in the program as outlined in the Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy current catalog. Application for the Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy current catalog is made a part of this agreement and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. This is a contract with the Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy for a program entitled "Your New Career in Taxidermy".
- 3. The Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy program consists of an eight-week course of instruction. Classes are held from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The program requires you to successfully complete 320 hours of instruction. Please see the student handbook or school website for exact course dates.
- 4. Students will receive a diploma upon successful completion of all courses. In order to graduate, a student must maintain a minimum C grade point average.
- 5. The cost for tuition at Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy for the entire eightweek course (320 hours) is \$9,800.00. There is also an application fee of \$150.00, for a total of \$9,950.00. The application fee and tuition are required to be paid in full by Cash or Check prior to the first day of class, other arrangements can be made for payment if necessary. Students will receive one of each of the following, airbrush & hose, color cup, paint brushes, stout ruffer, knives, regulator, modeling tool, scissors, ear splitters, scalpel handle, calipers, fleshing horn, tail zipper & stripper, cloth tape, needles and paint. Students will complete four birds' upland game birds/ ducks, three game heads, one life size, one rug, warm/cold water fish. Students may keep these items upon graduation. Students may purchase books from Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy, although these books are not required.

6.	Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy does not provide room or board for its students. However, there are several motels and beds & breakfasts in the area. Please see student handbook or school website for additional housing information.

- 8. Please see the student handbook regarding the refund policy at Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy. Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy will refund all tuition payments, A student will be entitled to receive 100% of tuition and application fee, if notified five days prior to first day of class. If no classes have been attended. A request for cancellation which is not made in writing shall be confirmed in writing by the student within an additional period of five calendar days. The school may retain all of the fee after five calendar days or after ten calendar days absent written confirmation. Refunds shall be made within thirty days of confirmed cancellation. Tuition refunds are issued on a pro-rated basis according to the date of withdrawal. A student will be entitled to receive 75% tuition refund if he withdraws up to the seventh day of class. A student will be entitled to receive a 55% tuition refund upon completing up to 25% of the course program. A student will be able to receive a 30% tuition refund upon completing up to 50% of the course program. After 50% of the course program is completed, a student will not be entitled to a refund. The withdrawal date of the student will be the last recorded date of attendance. If a student is rejected by Western Pennsylvania School of Taxidermy they are entitled to a refund of the application fee and tuition. Refunds will be issued within 30 calendar days of confirmed cancellation. Additional Cost may include turkey, antlers, felting or mammal rug. Optional for additional fee of \$500.00 for turkey.
